DATA POLICY OF THE ARCHIMEDE PROJECT

The "ARCHIMEDE" Project for constituting a public and shared archive of meteo-marine data has been presented during the workshop of 29-30 November held at the headquarter of the APAT in Via Curtatone. Moreover, themes concerning the gathering, standardization and sharing rules of data were discussed during the initiative.

The rules which constitutes the data policy of the archive are detected in respect to the aims of the Archimede project and to the way of participation to the archive by the side of public and private Institutions who carried out, in the course of time, activities in marine field:

- The Archimede Archive promotes the exchange and the diffusion of meteo-marine data at national and international level, but every Institution establishes its owns enforcing rules of data sharing;
- The data are available to Civil Guard (Protezione Civile) for their own Institution aims, all participants to the project having the possibility to access the whole archive in real time;
- The meta-data stored in the archive are public;
- The data cannot be used for commercial aims neither be released to third parties without prior authorization of the Institution who makes available the data;
- The archive is located at the APAT;
- The APAT goes surely that the rules for using data would be respected, it takes care on updating, standardizing, maintaining and managing the archive.
